

## **NEW PET CHECKLIST**



Planning ahead to ensure you have the resources (time & money) to care for a new puppy or adult dog is important. Here is everything you will need to consider:

- 1. **Routine Health Care** Initial puppy vaccinations & annual adult boosters; Regular flea & worming treatments; Health checks; Nail clips; Anal gland expression (depends on dog's needs)
- 2. **Oral Health Care** Daily teeth cleaning; Pet tooth gel & brushes; Dental water/food additives, chews & toys
- 3. **Treatments & Procedures** Neutering; Microchip (by law); Dental treatment; Investigations & treatment for illness & injury; Medication
- 4. **Emergency Vet Bills** Potential emergency care for acute illness or injury could be out of hours
- 5. **Pet Insurance** Read the small print for what is/isn't covered; Lifetime policies generally have the least limitations
- Nutrition Choose a complete Vet-recommended diet based on life-stage i.e. Puppy, Adult, or Senior
- 7. **Grooming** Depends on coat style, length & condition may need a seasonal trim; Pet shampoo for home care
- 8. Exercise & Enrichment Adequate exercise for breed; Bonding time; Enriching games & toys
- 9. **Training** Puppy training; Socialisation including loud noise training; May require behavioural training
- 10. **Holiday Care** Choices: Take your dog with you (if travelling abroad your dog will need an Animal Health Certificate, rabies vaccine & more); Send them to family/friends; A live-in sitter; Boarding kennels
- 11. **Needs & Accessories** Beds; Bowls; Lead; Collar; ID tag (by law); Car seatbelt or crate; Dog coat for cold weather
