

Is your dog allergic?

Dogs can develop allergies from many of the same environmental irritants as humans. Compare your dog's symptoms to our list below and book a vet check to find out the probable cause and get a treatment plan in place.

10 commons signs of allergies in dogs:



1. Itching

Constant scratching especially if it gets worse after going outside



2. Red, irritated skin

Rashes & hives on the belly, feet & between toes (common with grass & pollen allergies). Red skin around the mouth, chin & paws, also the anus in some cases



3. Obsessive licking

Constantly licking is a possible sign of an environmental allergy



4. Face/body rubbing

Dogs typically use carpets, pillows, furniture etc., to alleviate itchiness



5. Hot spots

Skin is so inflamed it becomes very red and can bleed; will also be hair loss



6. Hair loss

Untreated allergies and ongoing exposure to the cause can results in hair loss



7. Red, smelly ears

Inflamed ears; there may be an odour too



8. Head shaking

Your dog may also shy away or become aggressive when their head is touched



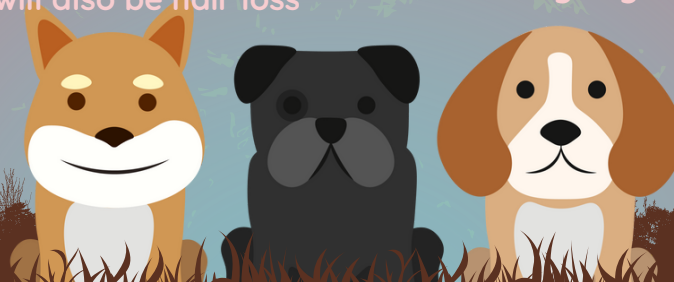
9. Puffy/runny eyes

Puffy, red eyes, and/or runny eyes; dogs may sneeze repeatedly too



10. Breathing issues

Airborne allergens can cause wheezing, coughing & respiratory distress
