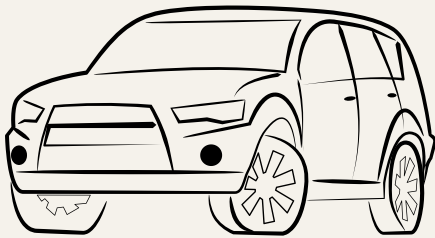
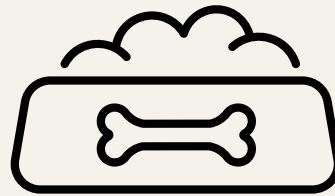


Dog Travel Sickness Tips for your holiday

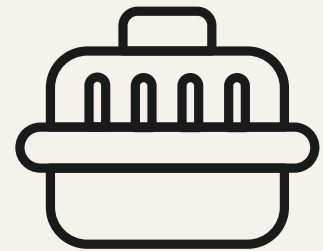
If your pet gets anxious and unwell on car journeys don't panic!

Build up your pet's tolerance levels weeks before your trip starting with short journeys - always praise them for successful trips



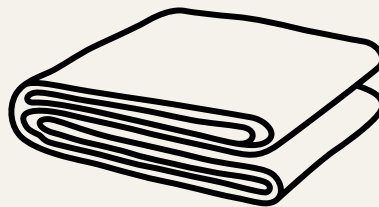
Limit food consumption before travelling



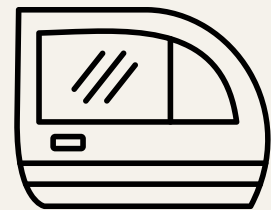
For comfort & safety dogs should face forwards and be secured in a dog seatbelt & harness or a crate



Spray some appeasing Pet Pheromones inside the car or crate before you set off



Give them their blanket and favourite toy in the car to try and pacify them



Keep your vehicle cool & well ventilated - lower windows slightly when moving to balance air pressure in the car
