

Dog Worm Prevention Tips



Parasitic worms can cause serious health problems in dogs, which is why prevention is the best strategy. Print off our dog worm prevention tips and use them as a daily reminder.



Use vet-recommend worming tablets that cover common worms including lungworm (typically every 1-3 months)



Use vet-recommend flea preventative products on dogs AND cats as fleas can pass on tapeworm



Snails and slugs can carry lungworm - don't let your dog eat them!



Avoid leaving your pet's bowls and toys outside overnight for slugs & snails to slime



Train your dog not to eat animal poop - ask our team for tips



Pick up your dog's poop from the garden (and anywhere else) regularly



Don't let your dog eat rodents or dead animals as these can be hosts for worms
