

How to grow an interactive edible garden for your small furry pets



Create a garden your pet can forage in and tunnel around at tea time for a bit of healthy and nutritional fun!

1

Drill some small holes for drainage in the base of your container e.g. a plant pot/trough, a safe plastic tray or a cat litter tray.

2

Line the tray with pebbles or gravel.

3

Add a thick layer of edible-flower soil (free from chemicals and growing agents).

4

Plant seeds you want to grow (cereal grass seeds: wheat, oat, rye, barley) as well as seeds to eat. For rabbits & guinea pigs you can also plant some veg.

5

Create pathways using pebbles. Top everything with wood shavings and add areas of interest e.g. hideaways & bridges.

6

Water your pet's edible garden daily and in a few days... VOILA! Your plants will begin to grow.
