How to keep your cat calm on a vet visit

Four steps for a successful visit to the vets



1. The cat carrier

- Let your cat play around the carrier before you visit.
- Perhaps pop some treats in there in the days before you travel.
- In the car, make sure the carrier is level and secure.

2. Familiar smells

- Clean the car and remove any air fresheners.
- Put familiar (smelling) blankets in and over the carrier.
- Use a pheromone spray if that helps.





3. In the waiting room

- Minimise your cat's time in the waiting room.
- Keep your cat away from other animals when waiting.
- Keeping the cat carrier on your lap or on our special stands can really help.

4. Offer treats

- Take your cat's favourite treats when you come to visit.
- Offer treats at points where they will reinforce positive aspects of the day.
- Handle your cat in the consultation room rather than the waiting room.
