

FOR PETS ****OUTDOORS?**

Minimal to no risk for dogs and cats, enjoy time outside with them. At 10 degrees and below it's time to bring outdoor small furry pets indoors.

Risk for dogs and cats is low. Be mindful: short dog walks with coats if needed, encourage cats in at night.

Temperatures can be dangerous for some dogs depending on breed, coat type, age & health. Be safe & vigilant with cats outside too and give more bedding to all pets.

These temperatures can be dangerous so keep pets warm. Dog coats and short walks are wise for some, keep an eye on them & paws.

This temperature is potentially lifethreatening. Dogs should go out for the toilet but avoid prolonged time outdoors. Bring cats indoors as much as possible. Outdoor time

for small furries is too dangerous.
