Prepare your Pet for Fireworks Night

Get your pet ready for the loud bangs & flashes before they start with our handy tick list. Stick it on your fridge to help you remember.

1 month before - Calm & desensitise

Talk to your vet about pet calming products & possible medication.

Practise noise desensitisation techniques with your dog gradually.

A few days before - Create a safe space

Cover their bed with a blanket, or make a den from household items.

Provide extra bedding, toys & treats, for a comforting safe haven.

On the day - Batten down the hatches

Exercise pets during the day and keep them indoors at night.

Secure cat flaps, shut windows, and draw the curtains.

Bring hutches indoors, or put your pet in an enclosed indoor space.

Turn the TV volume up a little to drown out the loud bangs.

Don't leave pets home alone too long; leave the radio on when out.

Give your pet extra cuddles, or leave them be if they prefer.
