



Removing a tick safely

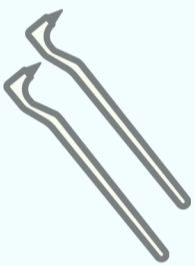

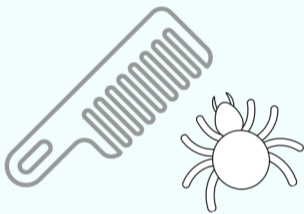
NEVER poke, prod, or cover a tick in vaseline to suffocate it. The tick needs to come out in one piece.

2



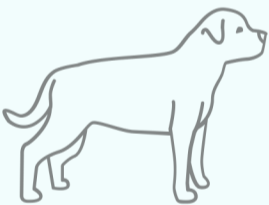
You will need a specially designed tick removal tool - you can buy a 2-pack from most vets, pet stores, and some online retailers.

3



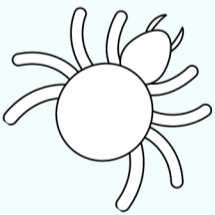
Once you have located the tick, part the surrounding fur.

4



Hook the tool under the tick as close to your pet's skin as possible.

5



Twist the tick whilst pulling, and ease it out.

6



Check there's no part of the tick stuck in your dog.

7



Dispose of the tick to stop it jumping onto your pet again, or you.
