If it's 6 or below, it's time to take action. Use our checklist to make improvements at home and be sure to ask our team for help.

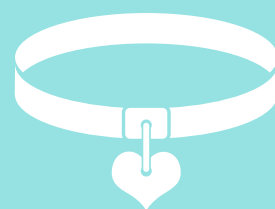
## 1 Is your cat chipped? Y/N

Quick, low cost, and vital if your cat gets lost or has an accident. We microchip cats in minutes.



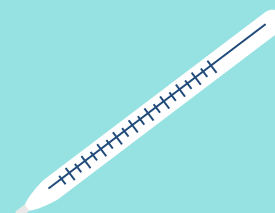
## 2 Does your cat wear a collar and ID tag? Y/N

Opt for a quick-release reflective collar and fit an ID tag. Can be trial & error, but worth it.



## 3 Do you protect your cat from hot weather dangers? Y/N

Invest in pet-specific sunblock and monitor your cat's time in 'hot spots'. Ask us for advice.



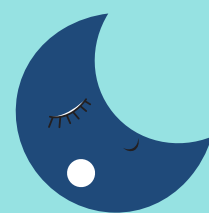
## 4 Are vaccinations & parasite treatments up to date? Y/N

Fleas, ticks & worms are more active in warmer months and carry diseases. If you're unsure, we can help.



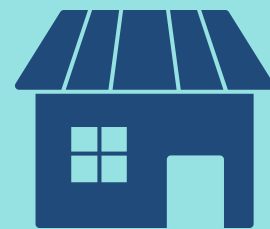
## 5 Have you set a 'light nights cat curfew? Y/N

Always keep the same evening meal time and encourage your cat indoors to avoid dangers at night.



## 6 Do neighbours know to look out for your cat? Y/N

Ask neighbours to check sheds, garages, greenhouses, and cars for your cat before closing up.



## 7 Are you careful when it comes to toxins & rubbish? Y/N

Store toxic substances in cabinets with doors. Clear up picnic & BBQ mess straight away.



## 8 Are your home & garden free from harmful plants? Y/N

Cats can't/won't avoid all poisonous plants. Research, remove harmful ones, and learn to spot the signs.



### Common signs your cat could have been poisoned:

Salivation  
Vomiting  
Diarrhoea

Skin Swelling/Inflammation  
Trouble Breathing  
Twitching/Fitting

Depression  
Shock  
Collapse/Coma
