GET A SUITABLE CARRIER



Get a properly rated pet carrier and make sure it's big enough for your pets to move around in, but small enough so they're comfortable and secure.



PLAN AHEAD

Before you travel, have a think about the trip.

- Do you have enough food and water?
- Can you travel at a cooler, quieter time of the day?
- Are there places you can stop to check on your pets?
- Do you have cleaning cloths in case your pet urinates or is unwell?



STICK TOGETHER

If your pet has a companion, take them both on the journey. They will lend each other support.



BUSSES, TRAINS & CARS

If you're travelling by car, ensure the pet carrier is properly secured in the back. If you're using public transport; check rules of carriage, do a practice run at a quiet time and do try to travel when it's cool.
