- Invest in a high vis or reflective collar for your cat. This will allow them to be visible to cars in the dark.

- Keep some of your cat's toys hidden away and get them out after dark to encourage them to stay inside.
- Microchip your pet just incase they get lost or spooked in the dark.
- Always check the wheel arches of your car in the morning, cats have a tendency to sleep on the wheels to stay warm.
